TEKaiir Frame Kit Replacement Guide





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1. Replacement Instruction

1.1 Control Box

a. Step 1

Disconnect the motor, power, and hand control cables from the control box.





b. Step 2

Detach the control box by depressing the side of the control box, and lifting both of its ends from the desk frame (See picture).







c. Step 3

Attach the new control box by pressing the plastic tabs on either end until it clicks into place.











d. Step 4

Plug the motor, power, and hand control cables into the control box.



e. Step 5

Perform the reset procedure:

- 1. Press and hold the \blacktriangle and \checkmark buttons on the hand control <u>simultaneously</u> for 3 seconds.
- 2. Continue holding both buttons until both legs reach their lowest position.
- 3. When reset is complete, the hand control will beep once, and the buttons can be released.

1.2 Hand Control

a. Step 1

Disconnect the power and hand control cables from the control box.







b. Step 2

Remove the two screws from the hand control.



c. Step 3

Fasten the new hand control onto the desk using the two screws mentioned above (See Step 2).



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d. Step 4

Plug the power and hand control cables to the control box.





e. Step 5

Perform the resetting procedure:

- 1. Press and hold the \blacktriangle and \checkmark buttons on the hand control <u>simultaneously</u> for 3 seconds.
- 2. Continue holding both buttons until both legs reach their lowest position.
- 3. When reset is complete, the hand control will beep once, and the buttons can be released.

1.3 Columns

a. Step 1

Perform the reset procedure:

- 1. Press and hold the \blacktriangle and \checkmark buttons on the hand control <u>simultaneously</u> for 3 seconds.
- 2. Continue holding both buttons until both legs reach their lowest position.
- 3. When reset is complete, the hand control will beep once, and the buttons can be released.

b. Step 2

Carefully flip the desk frame over, being careful to grab the frame itself and not the desktop, such that the desktop is down on the ground.







c. Step 3

Disconnect the motor and power cables from the control box.





d. Step 4

Remove the screws from the feet (4 screws per column, 8 screws for 2 columns in total).





e. Step 5

Remove the screws connecting the columns and the outer desk frame (4 screws per column, 8 screws for 2 columns in total).





f. Step 6

Install the new columns, fasten them and the end pipe brackets using screws that were previously embedded into the desk frame (4 screws per column, 8 screws for 2 columns in total).





g. Step 7

Reinstall the feet by tightening the screws. (4 screws per column, 8 screws for 2 columns in total).







h. Step 8

Plug the motor and power cables into the control box.





i. Step 9

r;motion

Flip the desk frame back over, careful not to grab it by the desktop, so the desktop is facing upward.



j. Step 10

Perform the reset procedure:

- 1. Press and hold the \blacktriangle and \triangledown buttons on the hand control <u>simultaneously</u> for 3 seconds.
- 2. Continue holding both buttons until both legs reach their lowest position.
- 3. When reset is complete, the hand control will beep once, and the buttons can be released.

2. Troubleshooting

Please refer to the chart (below) to diagnose and implement frame kit troubleshooting actions.

Damaged Cable	Identify components with damaged cables and replace them.	Cable or component with damaged cable.	
No Green Light on the control box	 Firmly connect AC power cable to control box. Test power outlet. 	If there is still no green light, replace the control box and AC power cable.

Cannot Reset (Synchronize)	 When the reset is not possible, press the hand control button, either Up or Down. If either one makes a click sound, it indicates the hand control may need to be replaced. Conditions: a. Press Up with a click sound, but Down makes no sound. b. Press Down with a click sound, but Up makes no sound. 	Hand control	
	Press both hand control Up and Down buttons. If both make a click sound, it indicates that the control box may need to be replaced.	Control Box	
No Movement: When pressing the "Up" or "Down" buttons, the control box makes a click sound, but the columns fail to move.	This indicates a control box problem.	Control Box
